WHAT IS CLIL?

CLIL is an abbreviation referring to an educational approach in which language and subject content are learnt together. In the case of CLIL in German (CLILiG), German language learning is combined with content from other subjects such as Science, Maths or Geography.

CLIL = Content and Language Integrated Learning

WHY CLIL?

- + CLIL increases learners' motivation and confidence in both the language and the subject
- + CLIL develops intercultural communication skills
- + CLIL provides opportunities to study content through different perspectives
- + CLIL enables increased contact with the target language

CLIL has been successfully introduced into many schools around the world.
