

Travelling exhibition „Germany’s Energiewende“

1. What’s it about?

The German Federal Government is often asked about its Energiewende abroad. At the same time, many people are surprised by the scale of the project. These multi-dimensional aspects and challenges are presented in our exhibition. It also shows that the Energiewende is not a short-term project. It will be implemented step by step until 2050. The exhibition covers various aspects of the Energiewende and presents its development since the 1970s. The various

stations of the exhibition cover: Energy efficiency, heating, mobility, renewable energies, costs for consumer, climate protection, nuclear power, economical aspects, international aspects, electricity grid, security of supply, energy storage, civil participation and the future of energy supply. Additionally, there is an entrance gate, a multi-media quiz table and a feedback station.

The exhibition was inaugurated in April 2016 in Beijing and has since been shown at about 30 locations in 13 different countries (as of January 2017). There are two English, one German, one Spanish and one Chinese version of the exhibition. An Arabic version is currently being prepared.
